Fish Stocking: Dick explained that the Fish stocking fund is at \$ 00.00 because we just spent the entire fund \$4,000 to stock the lake with \$2,000 of walleye and \$2,000 of sunfish. This money came from donations specifically for fish stocking, none was from the general fund.
